It seems natural to me that the artist's state of being shines through the work as much as the physical materials used. My intent is to offer reflective state of being with each piece.

As I draw or paint, my mind drifts into another place. Images spring up, surprising me with their strangeness, humor, and curious, quiet power ... images hint at rhythms in nature.
